DigCompEdu

Solo il **37%** conosce il framework DigCompEdu. La maggior parte degli insegnanti si autovaluta come “*Integratori (B1)*” (41%), seguiti da “*Esploratori (A2)*” (25%) e “*Esperti (B2)*” (21%).



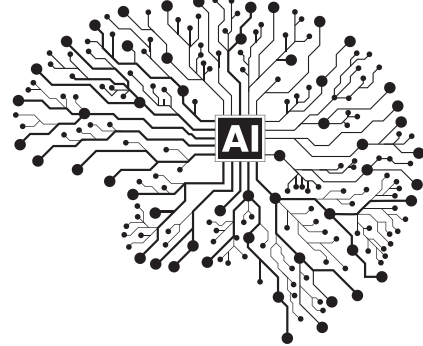
Il **60%** conosce gli strumenti di intelligenza artificiale, ma solo il **25%** li ha effettivamente utilizzati. L'**81%** degli insegnanti è interessato a opportunità di formazione.

Il **77%** ritiene che gli strumenti digitali possano migliorare l'esperienza di apprendimento degli studenti. Tuttavia, nonostante il **71%** ritiene di avere materiali sufficienti, il **79%** considera fondamentale una formazione specifica in questo ambito.

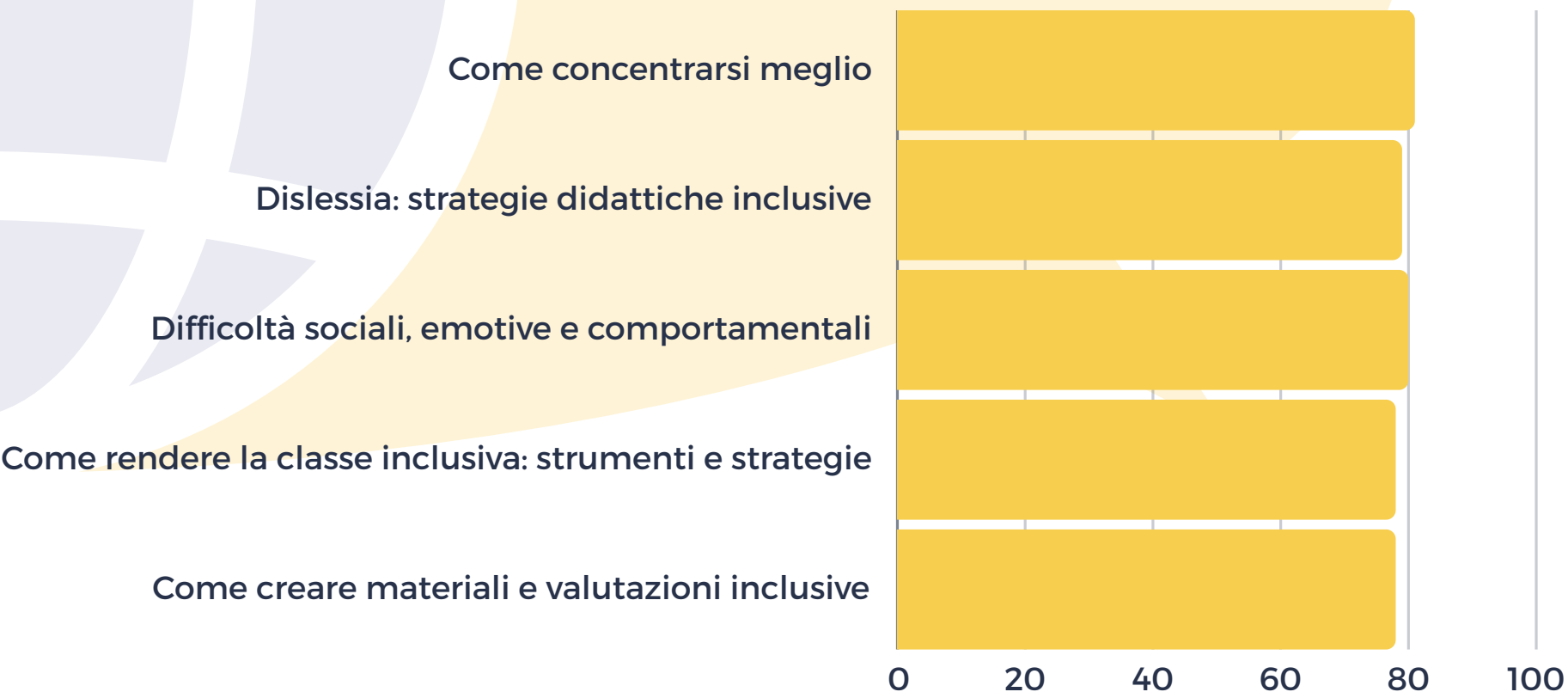
